Sean released January 5, 2021 from ASPC-Tucson. During his incarceration at ASPC-Catalina unit, Sean completed and graduated from Bridge Prison Ministry's one-year faith-based Reentry Mentor Program on October 2018. Upon his release, he transitioned to the Navarro House and started attending BPM's Community Reentry Mentor Support Group.

After a continual cycle of crime and recidivism with 10 years of incarceration, Sean made a decision to stay in Pima County and not to return to his old environment, Maricopa County.

With the guidance and support provided by BPM volunteers, Sean successfully transitioned back into society. He is currently employed at Tucson Heating and Plumbing and is now the house manager for the Silas Home of Bridge Prison Ministry.
